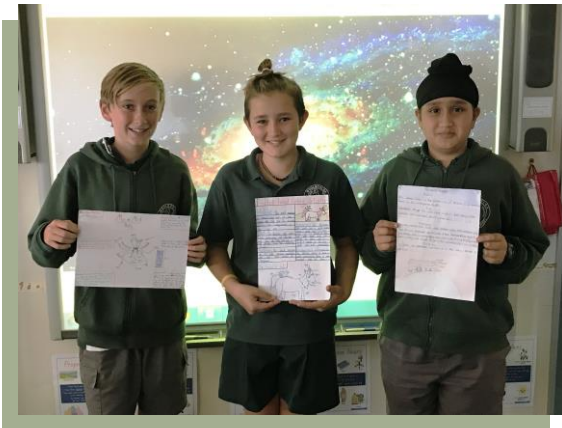
Congratulations to Simran Kaur of 5R. She will receive her Gold Award at Presentation Day.
