This is to ensure that all students have the correct number of Dollarmites tokens in their deposit wallets.

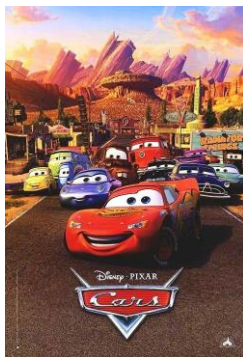
If your child can't find their wallet, please see Laura and she will issue a new one. Laura can also check if your child is eligible for a reward
