New Pedestrian Crossing

A new pedestrian crossing has been installed in Woolgoolga to replace the school crossing immediately north of the roundabout on Solitary Islands Way (the old Pacific Highway) near the Woolworths supermarket.

The opening of the Woolgoolga bypass highway upgrade has meant there is less traffic on Solitary Islands Way. However with the Woolworths development, there are also more people crossing the road to access the supermarket. As a result, a new permanent pedestrian crossing is now in place to support safe crossing for all pedestrians 24 hours a day.

Importantly please note, from *Monday, 25th September 2017*, there will no longer be a crossing supervisor at this location. As a transition, crossing supervisors will be educating children on road safety and the correct way to cross a pedestrian crossing. The 40km school zone and flashing lights will also be removed.
